### **New Business:**

Update on our GOF 2024: We are tentatively planning on having this event in Crystal River, Fl at the Plantation Resort. This is not official yet, but Scott Buie is working to hopefully finalize things soon. Details will be forthcoming at a future meeting.

Member Jim Young advised that he and his two sons, Daniel and A.J. will be attending Motor trend's 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Hot Rod Power Tour with his MGB. This tour is more than just a traveling car show–it's the largest hot rod road trip in the world. Classic cars and hot rods travel city to city, over 1,300 miles.

The 29th annual <u>HOT ROD Power Tour</u> Driven by Continental Tire kicks off at Atlanta Motor Speedway and will wind its way north through the Carolinas before concluding at Tennessee's Bristol Motor Speedway. It is regarded as the largest traveling car show, with 6,000 cars and trucks from all generations and tens of thousands of fans participating over a five-day road trip. Making this year's event more special is the celebration of HOT ROD's 75th Anniversary.

The Power Tour kicks off June 12, 2023, at Atlanta Motor Speedway before the group heads to the South Carolina Fairgrounds in Columbia, South Carolina. The tour spends hump day at the famed Rockingham Speedway in the city that bears the same name in North Carolina. The fourth day will be packed with excitement, as Power Tour takes over the legendary zMAX Dragway in Concord, North Carolina. The finale, on Friday, June 16, 2023, will take place at Bristol Motor Speedway in Bristol, Tennessee. Each stop will celebrate all things HOT ROD and include many activities such as drag racing, autocross, and other live entertainment.
