Up until that time, age 19, my experience around "grown-ups" was that they were always serious and didn't seem to have fun. The members of the club seemed to be friends first, inclusive of everyone, working on and sharing their love of MGs, they got together regularly, and obviously enjoyed each other's company.

In the mid 70s, Ellen and I approached her parents, Will and Carla, about having a New Year's Eve party at their home. They were already hosting the CMGC so they agreed as long as our party remained outdoors, so ours was held lakeside. It was a cold night so we had a bonfire. The night started as planned with two separate parties, but by midnight, the two parties had merged. A good time was had by all.

I believe the club has been special since its inception 60 years ago. The club has always been a completely elective activity. It has been comprised of people who enjoy living life with a common interest in MGs and their usage. I believe the CMGC maintains those interests. John and Jean Camichos, founding members, are still active in the club after 60 years. This is further evidence the value of the club has been retained.

On the drive home I pondered these questions, what do I need or have to do?, how does the club work?, and where can I find this information? I have been contacting active members I know and those members who have held office in the club. I have asked them: "What do you like about the club, and what are you looking for in the club?" I have spoken to four members with ten left on my list. I will be happy to meet with any other club member. This search is early and incomplete.

I've learned many things. The CMGC is similar to the cars we adore. The club has been in existence for 60 years, it is running but would benefit from some freshening or a partial restoration. For an example: rewrite and update new bylaws. I heard the original bylaws were limiting, only allowing members with T types, now we have MGs of all types. These original bylaws are lost, as no one seems to have a copy.

I want to promote driving our MGs to events and meetings. Interestingly, of the four people I interviewed three told me they would not drive their MG to a night meeting. This was not a concern with the car, but more with driver aging issues, vision, reflex's etc. Let's explore the topic of meetings with the time of day, day of the month, and the location to be discussed. Alternating between a day and night meeting could be an option. As an annual event, there is a St. Patrick's Day celebration event which encompasses delicious food, camaraderie and also to discuss and select Events for the rest of the year. This will be held at Mike and Carol McCormick's home with a date in March to be determined. I hope this will be well attended, so the club can plan and schedule some really fun events for 2024.
